Established in 2022, Athena Fund's ImagineBox program has gained significant attention and traction in Israel. At the end of Q1/26, Athena Fund had implemented over 130 ImagineBox immersive spaces throughout Israel, with an estimated total of about 200 ImagineBox deployments projected by the end of Q4/26. ImagineBox spaces also have been deployed in Israel's geographic and social periphery, helping to bridge educational gaps across the country.
